ABOUT BISS

BISS Bakeries is a Ugandan non-profit organisation (NGO), initiated by Bake for Life Holland. Since 2014, BISS has been operating from the capital Kampala. Through baking work and income are created for the vulnerable in Uganda. There are currently 199 small-scale BISS bakeries, spread over 21 regions, where entrepreneurs work independently. Bakeries are started using micro-credits in form of physical start-up-kits.

WHAT DOES BISS DO?

Jobs through baking, is our goal described in three words. We do this through four core activities. First of all, selecting new entrepreneurs. People with a passion for baking, but also with a vulnerability. These people then end up in an intensive practical baking and business training. After the training, participants receive a start-up-kit based on micro-credit. All physical items from workbench, scales to ingredients. After delivery, a field officer will remain on site for at least two weeks to give the bakery a kickstart. We will remain in contact for two years and carry out other follow-up programs.

SELECTION

We select participants together with partnering organizations in Uganda. The emphasis here is mainly on vulnerable people. 75% of the participants have a disability themselves or have a child with a disability. The success of a bakery starts with the right selection. That is why we use a 3-phase selection procedure at BISS.



TRAINING

The BISS training courses last 7 full weeks and are very practical. In addition to baking, several other skills are trained practically like sales, cost calculation, record keeping, hygiene, HRM and more. These training courses can take place on location or in our own training room.



START-UP-KITS

BISS has developed a franchise like model with not only equipment and ingredients, but also the branding. The start-up-kits are received immediately after the training so that participants start baking when the knowledge is still fresh. The start-up-kit is repaid during a period of 1-3 years. This is to demand more commitment and be less dependent of funding: the repayments start new bakeries for others!



FOLLOW-UP

For the first two weeks after opening the new bakeries, the bakeries will be supervised daily by a field officer from BISS. Visits will follow in the following two years depending on performance. Depending on needs and available funding, BISS organizes other follow-up activities such as refresher courses and regional meetings.

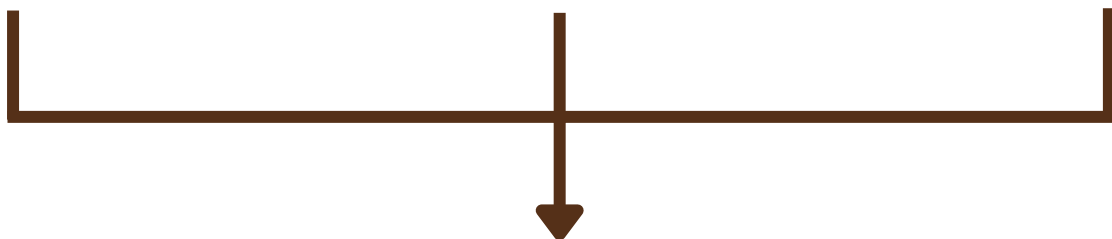

BISS works with a micro credit loan. The start-up kit that the bakers receive must be repaid within 3 years. If 3 bakeries repay the loan, a 4th bakery can be started in the 4th year from the repayments.
